◆ THE new labyrinth on the Cliff Field in Seaton was officially opened on Sunday afternoon. With Dave Kelf as the driving force behind the scheme, and designed with help from the Spiral Sanctuary in Axmouth, the major part of the construction work was undertaken by Tony Benger Landscaping, from Dalwood, assisted by a force of volunteers. The ribbon at the entrance to the labyrinth, which is half-a-mile long, was cut by David Shreeve, the director and co-founder of the Conservation Foundation.
