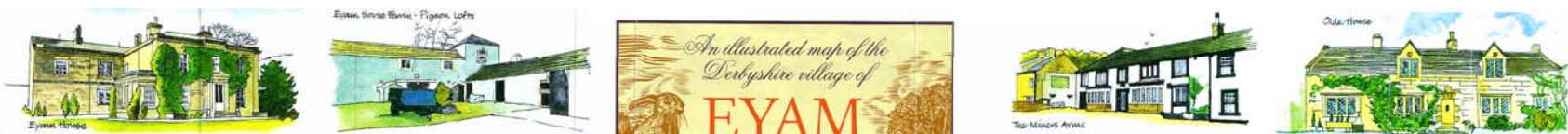


An illustrated map of the

KEY TO LATTER DATE ON MAIN MAP
 Around or near The Square

- 1) Sheep Store - Currently General, formerly known as Honey's Store was also known as Farmer's and was used as a cart shed.
- 2) Bakery - Currently a Bakery. Has been a barge, solicitors and wool shop.
- 3) George Siskel - Currently a Butcher has been a general grocer which also sold animal feed.
- 4) Curiosity - Currently gift and card shop - on site of wooden building which was a tobacconist.
- 5) Foreman The Foresters Inn.
- 6) When The Square - Currently a shop that been a butcher's shop, a sweet shop for the Old Bakery (read door), a cafe for fabric and carpets and was also used for distributing fat date before World War Two.
- Off The Causeway
- 7) Lower Bower, Top - Site of Old Side Mill and Boat Bakery. Now Anglo-Spanish Law firm, Work Psychology, restaurant and holiday cottages.
- 8) Watermill Shop - Currently dealing in antiques and gardenware for Dogmaton Hall.

Off The Causeway

- 9) Riding Bridge
- 10) Smiddy Shop - Currently manufacturing business was a blacksmith.
- 11) Watermill Shop - Currently dealing in antiques and gardenware for Dogmaton Hall.

On Church Green - 12) 7 Hoop - Currently a firm of Chartered Accountants, former row in Watermill on the same site.
