

Who were the iron-makers of Myers Wood?

A joint investigation by Huddersfield and District Archaeological Society and The University of Bradford



Investigation of this important mediaeval iron-making site in Myers Wood, Kirkburton, has revealed charcoal making, ore roasting, smelting and smithing - all, probably, carried out under the supervision of the Cistercian monks from Roche Abbey in the early 1300's. The investigation continues.
